### I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Kimberly Moore's welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order.

### II. MEETING MINUTES APPROVAL

Chair Kimberly Moore asked if everyone had the opportunity to review minutes from the May 12, 2020 meeting and asked for a motion to approve them.

**Motion:** A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes from the May 12, 2020 meeting of the Career Pathways Council; All in favor. **Action Item I Unanimously Approved.**

### III. Partner Updates

- Maria Mead (KU)- Classes resuming 8/31/2020 in a hybrid format. Sessions are recorded for students not able to attend. Offering a B.S. Nursing starting January 2021. Keiser University now has an articulation agreement with TCC.
- Shereada Hall (FAMU)- Classes starting in a hybrid format. FAMU holding an employer conference on 8/12/2020. FAMU is also hosting a virtual career expo on 9/23/2020-9/24/2020, via Handshake. Their plan is to increase community/employer engagement.
- Sean Friend (LTC)- Classes started 8/10/2020, with some programs offered in a hybrid format.
- Travis Jones (ACE)- In-person GED classes starting 8/31/2020.
- Chair Kimberly Moore (TCC)- Classes at 50% capacity on campus, for credit and degree-seeking students. Chair Moore also discussed tuition discount (50-100% off) for individuals impacted by Covid.
- Kevin Vaughn- Paid staff now on board
- Angela Sapp (GTI)- Enrollment is being limited to keep classroom sizes small.

### IV. COVID Community Impact

Members discussed various ways the community had been impacted by Covid. This included lack of childcare, as 50% of child care centers not operational, reduced working hours and concerns about evictions due to unemployment.
